Steve's Corner

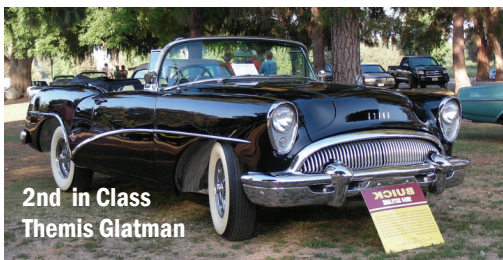
